RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE SUBSCRIBERS OF THE EDINBURG AND GARDAR TELEPHONE COMPANY

Do not use your telephone during thunder storms.

2. When through talking hang receiver on hook, and ring off by giving one sharp turn to the crank.

3. Inquiries for information as to train time will be answered by the operator, thus doing away with the necessity of calling the depot.

4. Answer the ring of your telephone promptly.

5. Single communications are limited to five minutes on party lines; three minutes on trunk lines.

6. The use of 'phone by parties other than subscribers, will be charged to the subscriber of 'phone so used at the rate of fifteen cents per message on the toll lines of this Company, and extra for messenger and long distance service.

7. All parties not subscribers, when calling central, will give their own name, state whose 'phone they are using and party they want. When through talking with party called, they will pay to the subscriber whose 'phone they used the regular toll rate.

8. Parties violating rules 6 and 7 will be charged double rates.

9. Subscribers and users of telephones on this system are positively forbidden to listen to the conversation of others. This rule must be obeyed, and anyone violating same will be cut off from the line for a period of 90 days. Each subscriber will be held responsible for the observance of this rule as far as his 'phone is concerned.

10. The use of profane or obscene language, playing of phonographs, singing, violin or piano playing, etc., over our wires is strictly forbidden. Subscribers will be held responsible for the enforcement of this rule; and, if such conduct is persistently indulged in, the telephone will be cut off from the line.

11. As we have long distance connections, it is necessary that we have the wire at once when such calls are made. When a call of this kind is made, the Central operator will call out "Long Distance," and you must hang up your receiver at once until such has been answered. Afterwards you can call up your party again and finish your talk.

12. Always obey request of central operator.

13. Do not leave the receiver off the hook.

14. On party lines never call central or anyone on the line without first taking the receiver off the hook to find out whether the line is in use. If the line is in use, hang up the receiver and await your turn.

15. **THE GENERAL RING**, (five long rings), is used only when the operator or one of the subscribers desires to communicate at once with all the subscribers on one of the toll lines, to summon aid in fighting a fire, etc. Such calls should therefore, be answered promptly in all cases.

This telephone system was constructed for the benefit of its patrons and stockholders. In order to have good service and a good system, you must observe the printed rules and regulations.

Look up number of party wanted before calling central, and when central asks for number wanted respond promptly by giving the number of party wanted in the order printed, thus—14 O 4 M, call one—four—O—four—M.
